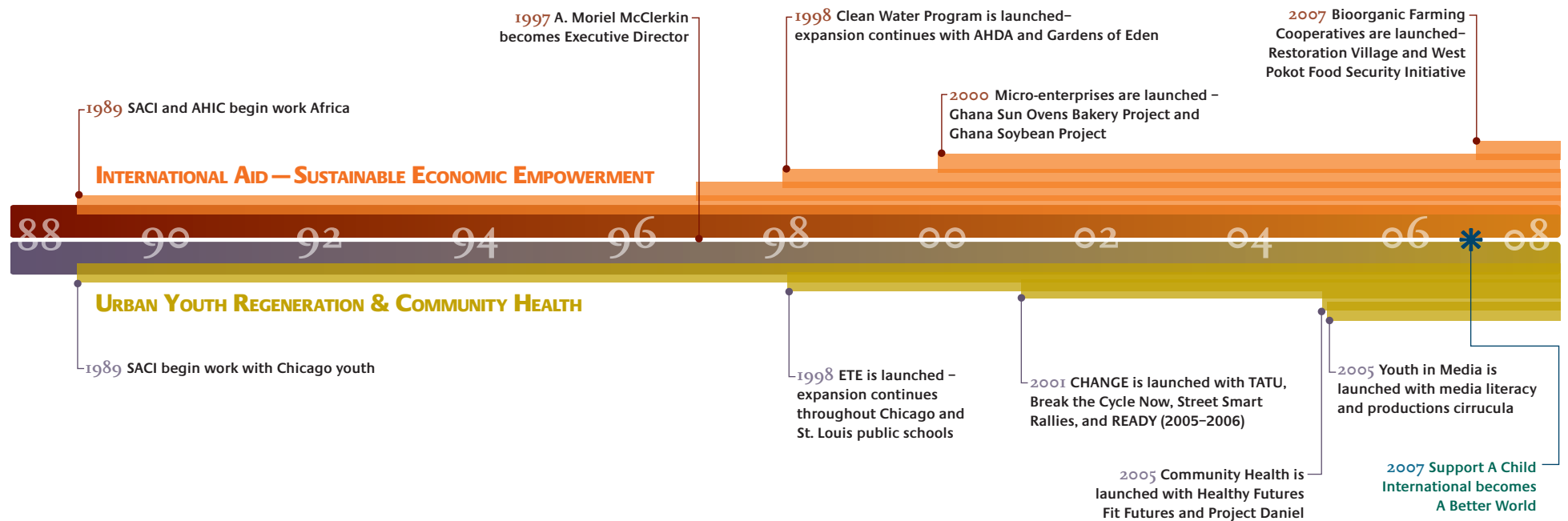

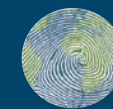

URBAN YOUTH REGENERATION & COMMUNITY HEALTH

January 1989 Support A Child International (SACI) is incorporated in Chicago

August 1997 A. Moriel McClerklin is hired as Executive Director

December 1997 Urban Youth International Journalism Program (UYIJP) is launched in Chicago

July 1998 Youth led tourism program in Chicago is launched

July 1999 Exodus to Excellence is launched in Chicago and serves over 4000 youth in two years.

June 2001 Character development and life skills program (the beginnings of CHANGE) is launched in Gary, Indiana.

December 2001 CHANGE program is launched in St. Louis

August 2003 Healthy Futures is launched through major grant from Missouri Foundation for Health (MFH)

February 2004 ETE is expanded to elementary schools through grant from Missouri Dept. of Elementary and Secondary Ed.

June 2005 Youth in Media Program is launched

August 2005 Youth media productions are featured at St. Louis theatre. First StreetSmart Rally is held

October 2005 Project READY (Renewing the Environment through the Actions of Dedicated Youth) is launched

March 2005 Healthy Futures is expanded to churches (Project Daniel)

November 2005 Healthy Futures is expanded significantly to schools and recreation centers through another MFH grant

February 2006 Project Daniel is officially launched and expanded to over 50 faith based communities.

October 2006 Fit Futures is launched from U. S. Department of Education grant

October 2006 Teens Against Tobacco Use (TATU) program is launched in high schools in St. Louis

May 2007 First Break the Cycle Rally is held

July 2007 Four new ETE centers are opened

INTERNATIONAL AID — SUSTAINABLE ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT

March 1989 SACI partners with the African Hebrew Israelite Community (AHIC) to begin charitable work in Africa

February 1998 Clean Water program is launched in partnership with African Hebrew Development Agency (AHDA)

July 1999 ETE Program is launched and serves over 4000 at-risk children in Chicago in a two year period

July 1999 SACI designated to promote trade between the State of Illinois and West African Countries

January 2000 Ghana Sun Ovens Bakery Project, a self-sustaining micro-enterprise is launched

April 2002 The Ghana Soybean Utilization Project is launched, a rural sustainable development initiative

January 2007 Clean Water program is expanded in Ghana through partnership with Gardens of Eden.

April 2007 Restoration Village Project (RPV), a bio-organic food cooperative is launched

April 2007 West Pokot Food Security Initiative is launched
